WELCOME TO THE KEEP OMAHA BEAUTIFUL, INC. HELPING HANDS PROGRAM

Helping Hands is a wonderful program brought to you by Keep Omaha Beautiful, Inc. to help elderly and disabled citizens **who cannot afford to pay for help** with a free, one time yard cleanup which will include raking, litter and limb pick up, and weed pulling. Mowing and other services may take place only if the volunteer group has the equipment and capability to do so. Bags, gloves, rakes, shovels, etc. will be provided by Keep Omaha Beautiful, Inc.

Getting Started

- ◆ The Helping Hands program was developed to give assistance to elderly and disabled citizens in our community **who cannot afford to pay for yard cleanup**.
- ◆ Call the KOB office and speak to Kay who will give you the name and address of a person to help
- ◆ It is recommended that you do a drive-by for an assessment of the residence (to see how much time is involved in the cleanup) and if it is a project your group can actually undertake.
- ◆ You will then contact that person directly to see if they would like your assistance. Then set up your date and time with them. **It is highly recommended that the resident be at home at the time of service.**
- ◆ It is also important that you explain to the resident that you **DO NOT** remove yard waste/litter from their property. You will place it curb side to be picked up on their normal trash pick up day or wherever they designate. For this reason, it is important that all yard waste and other litter are bundled and disposed of in the proper manner.
- ◆ **Do not go into the home of the resident you are helping.**
- ◆ We have many things available for you or your group to use: bags (lawn and litter); gloves; rakes; clippers; hedgers; etc. If there are items that you would like to use, you will need to contact **Kendra Sullivan at 850-4996** to set up a time to pick up those items at our storage facility. Appointments are set for **Monday's and Friday's at 12 noon**. Our storage facility is located at **2724 Douglas Street #314** (Dino's Storage). All tools and equipment are to be returned to Keep Omaha Beautiful, Inc. within a few days after the cleanup. **If tools are not returned or are broken your group will either replace them or be liable for the cost of replacement.** Residents may have items that are available for use and you can discuss that with them at the time of your initial conversation.
- ◆ The volunteer waiver form will need to be completed, signed by all volunteers and returned to our office. Upon completion of the project please fill out the forms that are enclosed and return it to: Kay Replogle-McDonnell / Keep Omaha Beautiful, Inc. / 1819 Farnam Street, Suite 306 / Omaha, NE 68183. You will also need to contact Kendra Sullivan at 850-4996 to return any equipment that was borrowed.
