

Overview

Keep Omaha Beautiful has planted over 4,500 trees since 2018 in fulfillment of our mission of fostering environmental and community stewardship through education, service, and advocacy. After five years of replacing trees affected by the invasive Emerald Ash Borer, we launched our Trees for Tomorrow program with the generous support of public and private philanthropic partners. Each year, we plant between 500-600 trees at Omaha's city parks, along trails and streets, and at local schools. With a 95% year-one survival rate, our trees help reduce urban temperatures during the hot summer months, mitigate greenhouse gas emissions, reduce noise pollution, provide habitat for wildlife, assist with stormwater management and water retention, replace storm-damaged trees, and improve Omaha's overall health and well-being.

Seedling Supporter - \$2,500

Six to Twelve Co-Sponsorships Available per Year

Overview

- Support Keep Omaha Beautiful's Trees for Tomorrow School Program by supporting an individual tree
 planting at a local school.
- Trees for Tomorrow School Program tree plantings vary from 4 to 10 trees. All trees are planted by students as the culminating event after a multi-week education program.
- School tree plantings occur four times per year, two in the spring and two in the fall.
- Costs vary based on the number of trees planted at the selected school. Sponsorship also supports program supplies for the education portion of the program.
- Past examples include: Planting at Liberty Elementary (2024), where four trees were planted with the assistance of 90 students, and Northwest High School (2022), where 25 trees were planted by 30 students.

Tree Planting Sponsor - \$5,000

Six Co-Sponsorships Available per Year

Overview

- Support one volunteer tree-planting event in Keep Omaha Beautiful's *Trees for Tomorrow* program.
- Volunteer tree plantings vary from 40 to 200+ trees and activate between 50 and 100+ volunteers, depending on the park selected for that year.
- Volunteer tree plantings occur at least once yearly, typically in the fall, in public spaces such as parks or trails.
- Costs vary based on the number of trees planted in the selected park.
- Past examples include: Ta-Ha-Zouka Park (2024), where 75 trees were planted by 100 volunteers, and the North Omaha Trail (2022), where 169 trees were planted by 100+ volunteers.

Annual Tree Champion - \$10,000+

Three Sponsorships Available per Year

Overview

- Support all Keep Omaha Beautiful's Trees for Tomorrow School Program tree planting events.
- *Trees for Tomorrow School Program* tree plantings involve approximately 10 trees based on school need. All trees are planted by students as the culminating event after a multi-week education program.
- School tree plantings occur four times per year, two in the spring and two in the fall.
- Costs vary based on the number of trees planted at each selected school. Sponsorship also supports program supplies for the education portion of the program.
- Past examples include: Planting at Liberty Elementary (2024), where four trees were planted with the assistance of 90 students, and Northwest High School (2022), where 25 trees were planted by 30 students.

Annual Canopy Caretaker - \$15,000

Three Sponsorships Available per Year

Overview

- Support Keep Omaha Beautiful's *Trees for Tomorrow* program and the Omaha tree canopy by sponsoring <u>all</u> tree plantings for the year, including volunteer plantings and <u>all Trees for Tomorrow School Program</u> tree-planting events.
- Volunteer tree plantings vary from 40 to 200+ trees and activate between 20 and 100+ volunteers, depending on the park selected for that year.
 - Volunteer tree plantings occur at least once per year, typically in the fall, in public spaces such as parks or trails.
 - Costs vary based on the number of trees planted in the selected park.
 - Past examples include: Ta-Ha-Zouka Park (2024), where 75 trees were planted by 100 volunteers, and the North Omaha Trail (2022), where 169 trees were planted by 100+ volunteers.
- *Trees for Tomorrow School Program* plantings vary from 4 to 20+ trees. All trees are planted by students as the culminating event after a multi-week education program.
 - School tree plantings occur four times per year, two in the spring and two in the fall.
 - Costs vary based on the number of trees planted at selected schools. Sponsorship also supports program supplies for the education portion of the program at all schools.
 - Past examples include: Planting at Liberty Elementary (2024), where four trees were planted by 90 students, and Northwest High School (2022), where 25 trees were planted by 30 students.

Private Planting Event - \$25,000+ (40 or more trees)

One Sponsorship Available per Year

Overview

- Support Keep Omaha Beautiful's *Trees for Tomorrow* Program by hosting a private tree planting. The host organization will serve as the exclusive sponsor for this planting.
- Employees and their family members and/or guests from your organization can volunteer to help plant trees in a pre-selected public location in the spring or fall. *Due to KOB's event schedule, spring is preferred.
- The planting date will be determined based on the availability of your organization and Keep Omaha Beautiful. A backup rain date will also be selected.
- The planting event will start with an educational presentation and demonstration tree planting. Volunteers will then break up into groups of 3 to 5 to plant trees.
- Holes will be pre-augered by KOB's contractor, and trees and bags of mulch will be preset near the holes.
- Employee volunteers will plant the trees using the excavated soil and place mulch around the planting sites. KOB will provide all supplies (shovels, rakes, gloves, etc.).
- KOB coordinates all arrangements for the sponsored tree planting, including: permit approvals for planting locations, coordinating with Omaha's Parks & Recreation Department and the planting contractor, and arranging tree maintenance and watering during the critical establishment period.
- KOB staff will send reminder emails and information to all employee volunteers before the tree planting and be onsite to coordinate all employee volunteers for the planting day.
- Past examples include: Crosskey Villages and Hefflinger Park (2021), where employee volunteers planted 90 trees.

 opportunities can either be exclusive to the organization's employees or opened up to employee family
 members and guests.
- KOB can provide all attendees with refreshments, such as tree-themed cookies or a similar treat after the event.
- If your organization would like to coordinate other activities as part of the planting day, such as a food truck or catered lunch, you are welcome to do so. This would not be included in the sponsorship, but KOB can adjust the schedule around other planned activities with advance notice.
