



PARTICIPATE IN YOUR NEIGHBORHOOD'S FALL CLEANUP!

DESCRIPTION & ELIGIBILITY

The Omaha Fall Cleanup is a joint effort between the City of Omaha and your neighborhood. The free event provides Omaha residents with the opportunity to properly dispose of and recycle large or bulky items that are not typically accepted through your curbside trash and recycling service, such as broken furniture, appliances, and mattresses. You do not have to be an official member of your neighborhood or homeowner association to participate.

ACCEPTED MATERIALS & SPECIAL ITEMS

You can bring approved bulky materials to your neighborhood site on the date and time noted below. Appliances, tires, and lead acid batteries are accepted as part of the Omaha Fall Cleanup, but they are considered "special regulated items" so they may have collection sites that differ from your neighborhood location. See below for details. Yardwaste will only be collected at 5225 Dayton St.

PROHIBITED ITEMS

The following items are NOT ACCEPTED at the Omaha Fall Cleanup: rocks, concrete, commercial waste, and any items that can be collected via your curbside trash and recycling service. Toxic materials (paint, oil, pesticides, and other chemicals) are also NOT ACCEPTED and should be taken to the UnderTheSink facility near 120th & I Streets (UnderTheSink.org). UnderTheSink is open 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on OFC Saturdays.
